#### **TagAway**

TagAway is a biodegradable graffiti remover designed for getting rid of the most difficult paints and staining agents. It contains no NMP, chlorinated solvent or fuel fractions. It can be used indoor and outdoor, on most substrates and more specifically on our anti-graffiti films like LAG100, PG7036, PG7075 and PG7092.

# **CLEANING PROCEDURE**

Always remove the graffiti as soon as possible to ensure the best result. Apply a thin layer of TagAway on the graffiti with a paint brush. Let it stand for  $\sim$ 2 minutes before :

-first cleaning with a soft brush or a piece of cloth

-then rinse off using a pressurised water gun (Kärcher). The rotating brush of the pressurised water gun should not be used to clean the visual.

If there are several layers of graffiti or graffiti still remains, repeat the above procedure until all graffiti has been removed.

## **SHELF LIFE**

1 year when stored at normal conditions (temp. > 5 °C are needed).

The container cap should be securely sealed after use.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

Although TagAway can be used on most surfaces, we recommend to use it on our anti-graffiti films like LAG100, NoTag series, PG/LUV 7036, PG 7075..... On other substrates, we always recommend to carry out a trial on a small surface.

Never mix the TagAway with another product Do not decant in another container. Please consult MSDS for further information.
